



Requests for Service/ Referral Policy & Procedure

Who can apply to use our service

- Anyone with learning disabilities (or a child with complex needs likely to go on to use adult learning disabilities services) can make a request to use our service. This includes any child or young person on the autistic spectrum.
- They can make a request via any route: family, social work, NHS, care providers, schools, college and day services.
- We can consider requests re people on the autistic spectrum.
- We are often able to cope with service users who have profound and multiple disabilities, usually by providing the service at home.
- Volunteers are not able to provide personal care, but links can sometimes be organised to work around this
- Challenging behaviour that would pose a risk to a volunteer or be beyond what we could expect a volunteer to cope with is likely to make a befriending link unfeasible.
- Unfortunately we are unable to offer a service to those with ADHD, dyslexia or specific learning difficulties who do not have learning disabilities.
